This USPATH Scientific Symposium is a professional continuing education conference for medical and mental health providers, and researchers. Providing gender-affirming NURSING CARE for transgender and gender nonbinary people across the lifespan	Through a nursing lens, we will be examining the holistic health of the transgender patient and how we, as health care professionals, can best help our clients reach their optimal state of well-being. The pre-course is designed for and delivered by nurses. Though, all medical and clinical providers, as well as allied health professionals (e.g., nurse practitioners, physician assistants, social workers, physical and occupational therapists, case managers) are welcome to attend. Topics include: Transgender and gender nonbinary identities; terminology; gender identity development; name, pronouns, gender markers; social and health inequities; health status and health concerns; social and medical transitions; electronic health records; health insurance implications; establishment of affirming healthcare environments; psychosocial considerations to care delivery; and delivery of gender-affirming care. Time will be allotted to discuss participants' best practices and their challenges in the delivery of gender-affirming care.
