ESTABLISHING STANDARDS OF CARE FOR TRANS AND GENDER DIVERSE PEOPLE

WPATH has established internationally accepted Standards of Care (SOC) in transgender health. The Standards of Care are updated and revised as new scientific information becomes available. The 8th revision of the Standards of Care (SOC8) will be published and available as an open-access document in 2022.

WPATH publishes the Standards of Care which provide safe and effective pathways for transgender and gender diverse people to align their lives and bodies with their internal sense of gender identity, in order to maximize their overall health and to promote psychological well-being and self-fulfillment.

GOALS AND TASKS

As an international interdisciplinary, professional organization, WPATH works to further the understanding of the range of interventions, modalities, and medical and surgical gender affirming treatments for those who experience gender incongruence by professionals in medicine, psychology, law, social work, counseling, psychotherapy, family studies, sociology, anthropology, sexology, speech and voice therapy, and other related fields.

WPATH provides opportunities for professionals from various sub-specialties to communicate with each other in the context of research and treatment of gender incongruence including supporting our scientific symposium.
