Best Practices: Foundations in Transgender Health *intended for providers of all experience levels* is a 2-day training course for healthcare professionals from all specialties in the implementation of the Standards of Care. What all providers should know about gender development, mental health considerations, legal, policy and ethical issues, primary care and preventative health, puberty blockers and hormonal treatment, surgical overviews and much more. Includes interactive multi-disciplinary case studies.

Best Practices in Advanced Medical Treatment is a full-day training that focuses on advanced hormonal treatment and complications, co-occurring conditions, general

health, ongoing primary care and aging. A complicated case studies discussion helps to further understanding care and treatment among multiple medical specialties.

Best Practices in Advanced Mental Health is a full-day training that dives into advanced psychotherapy topics across the lifespan, navigating therapy issues like counter transference, children of transgender people, reidentification, autism, trauma and a complicated cases panel.
